When a parent/guardian, student and school nurse agree that self-administration of non-prescription pain relief medications is appropriate, the procedure must be done safely, carefully and accurately. A written request by the parent/guardian must be provided to the school. The medication must be brought to school in the **original container** for the student to keep with them. Medications may not contain ephedrine or pseudoephedrine as its sole active ingredient or as one of its active ingredients. Students found in possession of such medications may face disciplinary action. Requests must be renewed annually.

The school district may revoke a student's privilege to possess and use nonprescription pain relievers if the school district determines that the student is abusing the privilege. This agreement is not valid until signed by a district nurse.

*A secondary student may possess and use nonprescription pain relief in a manner consistent with the labeling, if the school district has received written authorization from the student's parent or guardian permitting the student to self-administer the medication. The parent or guardian must submit written authorization for the student to self-administer the medication each school year. The school district may revoke a student's privilege to possess and use nonprescription pain relievers if the school district determines that the student is abusing the privilege. This provision does not apply to the possession or use of any drug or product containing ephedrine or pseudoephedrine as its sole active ingredient or as one of its active ingredients. See Minn.
